At the March 7, 2018 meeting of the Weld County Board Of County Commissioners Julie Cozad voted to approve the Consent Agenda which had a Warrant Payment of \$12,268.57 (check # 3331998) to herself for legal expenses incurred during the defense of an Independent Ethics Commission Complaint currently on the Independent Ethic Commission's docket. There was no official public discussion, debate, public notice or recorded discussion on this matter. Mrs. Cozad was well aware that the warrant in question was on the consent agenda as discussion on the matter occurred at a work session dated February 26,2018. At this work session the matter was brought before the board and as attached notes indictate was voted on by all members of the Weld Board of County Commissioners. Description of acts or things complained of (continued):

Weld County Attorney Bruce Barker that contains a full explanation of the matter at hand. I am asserting that Julie Cozad is in direct violation of C.R.S. 24-18-109 (3)(a): A. The member of the governing body of a local government who has a personal or private interest in any matter proposed or pending before the governing body shall disclose such interest to the governing body and shall not vote thereon and shall refrain from attempting to influence the decisions of the other members of the governing body in voting on the matter. C.R.S. § 24-18-109(3)(a).

I furthermore assert that she is in direct violation of the Colorado Criminal Code: C.R.S. 18-8-308: Failing to disclose a conflict of interest.

(1) A public servant commits failing to disclose a conflict of interest if he exercises any substantial discretionary function in connection with a government contract, purchase, payment, or other pecuniary transaction without having given seventy-two hours' actual advance written notice to the secretary of state and to the governing body of the government which employs the public servant of the existence of a known potential conflicting interest of the public servant in the transaction with reference to which he is about to act in his official capacity.

(2) A "potential conflicting interest" exists when the public servant is a director, president, general manager, or similar executive officer or owns or controls directly or indirectly a substantial interest in any nongovernmental entity participating in the transaction.

(3) Failing to disclose a conflict of interest is a class 2 misdemeanor.

I furthermore assert that Julie Cozad did not disclose the conflict of interest to the Secretary of State's office as we have provided a printout of a search for conflict of interest statements from the Secretary of States office. This print-out demonstrated Julie Cozad is well aware of the need to disclose such conflicts of interest as it will read that she has filed the documentation 20 instances previously, and it is apparent that she is familiar with the process to do so.



 **MINUTES:** Commissioner Cozad moved to approve the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners meeting of March 5, 2018, as printed. Commissioner Freeman seconded the motion, and it carried unanimously.
