- 55. Upon motion duly seconded, the Commission unanimously dismissed Complaint 17-12 as frivolous under Rule 7.G.1.
- 56. The Commission held its annual election of officers. Upon motion duly seconded, the Commission unanimously elected Commissioner Smith to serve as chair and Commissioner Jones to serve as vice-chair.
