#### RESPONSE

Respondent Colorado Secretary of State Wayne Williams respectfully submits this Response pursuant to Rule 7(K)(2) of the Independent Ethics Commission (IEC) Rules of Procedure, through his counsel, Suzanne Staiert. To the best of the undersigned's knowledge, information, and belief, any statements set out in the response are true.

#### RESPONSE TO COMPLAINT

- 1. Respondent Wayne Williams is the Colorado Secretary of State.
- 2. On October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018, Tyler Boschert filed a complaint alleging that Secretary Williams used state funds for personal purposes. Most of the allegations are well outside the one-year statute of limitations approved by the voters in Amendment 41. It is undersigned Counsel's understanding that only the matters under consideration by the Commission are Secretary Williams' attorney registration fee (\$325), Colorado Bar Association dues (\$430), and a continuing legal education course (CLE), (\$20).
- 3. Secretary Williams is one of many attorneys in the office that are reimbursed for attorney registration fees, Bar Association dues and legal education. The office also reimburses employees for testing fees and courses for various certifications related to their jobs such as Information Technology, accounting, certified elections and registration administration, and project management.<sup>1</sup> Among these other membership organization and certification fees:
  - International Association Commercial Administrators
  - National Cybersecurity Center
  - Election Center Membership
  - Colorado Technology Association
  - National Association of Secretaries of State
  - Colorado Fiscal Managers Association
  - State Employees Leading Colorado
  - Council on Governmental Ethics Laws
  - Colorado Government Finance Officers Association

- 4. None of the memberships or licenses listed in the exhibit are "required" for employment.
- 5. It has long been the department's practice to pay dues for employee membership in various organizations and specifically to pay CLE fees for attorneys. The practice of paying these fees dates back to at least 2000.<sup>2</sup>
- 6. The Department has a number of business purposes to pay these costs:
  - Recruit and retain highly-skilled professionals
  - Maintain high performance standards by ensuring employees are current on their professional best-practices
  - Build a culture of innovation by ensuring that employees are well-versed in developing technology tools and applications
  - Protect Coloradoans by providing staff with state-of-the-art security tools, techniques, and practice events
- 7. The employee handbook for the department specifically states a policy for payment of attorney fees and legal education.<sup>3</sup> The policy pre-dates Secretary Williams' term and he was, at all times, within the policy.
- 8. Other state agencies also for pay licensing fees, Bar membership dues, and CLE for attorneys in the office that are not required to be licensed as a condition of employment. The State Patrol, Department of Education, Parks and Wildlife, and Executive staff in the Department of Personnel Administration pay for similar costs.<sup>4</sup>
- 9. The Secretary performs many functions for which being an attorney may not be required, but is certainly an advantage. Election administration is driven by a statutory framework. As the chief election administrator of the state, the Secretary is tasked with making uniform interpretations of the election code, promulgating rules, and enforcing the code by injunction.<sup>5</sup>
- 10. The Secretary also conducts hearings under the Administrative Procedure Act and chairs the State Title Setting Board. The Secretary conducts many of his own rule-making hearings, negotiates agreements, may be required to testify in court, teaches legal education courses on election law, attends the Colorado lawyer's committee election law section, guest lectures at law schools, and trains elections officials on legal issues.
- 11. As a member of the Colorado Bar Association, the Secretary and members of the staff are involved in various section committees including business law and government counsel. The office works with the Bar Association on legislation and through membership committees, advocates positions in the legislature. From 2014 2016, the Deputy Secretary of State chaired the government counsel section and the Department's manager of legal and policy served as the legislative liaison to the Bar Association's legislative policy committee.

- 12. Finally, the Complaint cites a \$20 CLE as a violation of Amendment 41. The CLE in question was "Reviewing the Supreme Court's 2017/2018 Term: A Panel Discussion." The discussion was moderated by Supreme Court Justice Melissa Hart. It included a discussion of election cases on topics affecting Colorado such as electioneering near a polling place, voter list maintenance, redistricting, and reapportionment.
- 13. The purposes for Secretary Williams' attendance were permissible and included becoming educated on issues related to the office.
- 14. There is nothing in Article XXIX that specifically covers these expenses. To the extent the conduct does fall within the jurisdiction of the commission, Article 29(3)(3)(h) provides an exception to any prohibition if the thing of value is, "a component of the compensation paid or other incentive given to the recipient in the normal course of employment." Attorney registration, Bar dues, and CLEs are exactly that. They are a component of employment for any attorney in the office, and have been for at least 18 years.
- 15. The expenses in question are compliant with state fiscal rules and have been regularly allocated in the budget, approved by the legislature, and subject to a yearly review by state auditors.
- 16. Secretary Williams' actions did not violate any ethical code, any standard of conduct, or any reporting requirement under Colorado law.

## **AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES**

- 1. Secretary Williams did not knowingly receive or accept any prohibited gift.
- 2. All expenses were a benefit to the state.
- 3. Secretary Williams did not receive a "private gain" or "personal financial gain" as defined by C.R.S. 24-18.5-101(5)(b)(II).
- 4. The expenses are a component of the compensation paid or other incentive given to the recipient in the normal course of employment.
- 5. The complaint is frivolous and groundless.

## **RELIEF SOUGHT**

- 1. Dismissal of all claims in the Complaint.
- 2. To the extent the IEC considers any allegation, that any determination be based on the responses submitted above.

I have access to limited financial data going back to FY 2001 (July 1, 2000 – June 30, 2001). In FY 2001, we made a payment totaling \$520.00 to the Colorado Bar Association. The payment description information associated with this amount includes two references:

- \$265.00 Colo Bar Assoc Dues #2899
- \$255.00 Colo Bar Assoc Dues #07753

I do not have any record of which employees were covered by these dues payments in FY 2001. In FY 2002 (July 1, 2001 – June 30, 2002), we made two payments totaling \$1,590.00 to the Colorado Bar Association:

- 1. \$795.00 in bar association membership for 2001-02 for Shea, Whitelaw, and Hobbs (only last names provided). This payment was made in July 2001.
- 2. \$795.00 to the bar association in June 2002. This payment only references two employee names: Michael Shea for \$245.00 and Keith Whitelaw for \$280.00. No memo was recorded for the remaining \$270.00.

## 22. Policy for Attorneys on Dues and Continuing Legal Education

The Department will pay attorney registration and bar dues for members (including section dues if the section is relevant to the attorney's duties in the Office).

Generally, continuing legal education is the responsibility of each attorney; and attorneys are encouraged to coordinate on the purchase of recorded CLE programs. The department may occasionally pay for attendance at a CLE program or for a recording if there is a benefit to the Office.

When attorneys wish to use scheduled work time to attend a continuing legal education program, they may use paid administrative leave (upon request) if the program relates to their duties in the office. Otherwise, they may use either annual leave or paid administrative leave "for the good of the state" under Personnel Director's Administrative Procedure 5-19.

In most cases, the Office will pay for the cost of attorneys to register and attend an annual CLE conference that is directly relevant to their program responsibilities in the Office, and such attorneys may use paid work time or paid administrative leave. Examples include attorneys in the Business & Licensing Division who attend the annual Business Law Institute or the annual conference on Advising Nonprofit Organizations in Colorado.

## 23. Emergency Evacuation Procedures

To prepare for a possible emergency, 1700 Broadway building management (Broe) works closely with the City of Denver's Fire and Police Departments to assess conditions, anticipate possible risks, and develop and maintain a comprehensive Emergency Action Plan to which employees and visitors should adhere at the onset of an emergency until Fire and Police teams arrive.

These procedures are intended to prepare staff and visitors for an emergency that might occur while inside the 1700 Broadway building, and to provide clear instructions on the actions required during the first minutes of an emergency. These actions will reduce the potential for injury through calm and organized communication and reaction. The procedures must be followed unless Fire or Police Department officials state otherwise. All employees shall follow the instructions of their assigned Floor Wardens. Please read and become familiar with the emergency procedures of 1700 Broadway.
