### I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- 7. Upon motion duly seconded, the Commission unanimously authorized the Office of the Attorney General to pursue subpoena enforcement for John Hickenlooper in Denver District Court.
- 8. The Commission commenced the hearing for Complaints 18-22 and 18-29.
- 9. The Commission accepted the stipulation of the parties as to the admissibility of exhibits 101-105, 108, 110-115, 118, 119, 121-137, and 201-205.
- 10. The Commission recessed at 12:15 p.m. and reconvened at 12:40 p.m.

11. At 1:50 p.m., upon motion duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to enter executive session pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-6-402(3)(a)(II), to discuss Complaints 18-22 and 18-29, for purposes of receiving legal advice on specific legal questions.
