Minutes of the March 21, 2023, Meeting Meeting Conducted by Web Conference

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- 3. The Commission unanimously approved the minutes of the January 9, 2023, special meeting (Commissioners Wist and Mercer abstaining).
- 4. The Commission unanimously approved the minutes of the February 21, 2022, meeting.
- 5. Mr. Ioannides provided the staff report.

- 15. The parties having committed to their availability for a hearing on the merits, the hearing for Complaints 16-02 and 17-14 was set for August 15, 2023. The Notice of Hearing will be issued to the parties in due course.

At 10:41 a.m., upon motion duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to enter closed session to discuss Complaints 22-31, 23-02, 23-03, and 23-04, for purposes of receiving legal advice and which are required to be kept confidential pursuant to Article XXIX, §5(3)(b) of the Colorado Constitution.
