# **COLORADO INDEPENDENT ETHICS COMMISSION**

Minutes of the September 19, 2023, Meeting Meeting Conducted by Web Conference

### I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- At 9:47 a.m., upon motion duly seconded, the Commission voted unanimously to enter closed session to discuss Position Statement 16-01 and the draft position statement for purposes of receiving legal advice; and Complaints 23-14, 23-18, 23-19, 23-20, 23-21, 23-22, and 23-23, for purposes of receiving legal advice and which are required to be kept confidential pursuant to Article XXIX, §5(3)(b) of the Colorado Constitution.
